GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Application should be in the prescribed format, and should be accompanied by self-attested copies of documents on educational qualifications, research experience, UGC certificate (if applicable), extracurricular activities, date of birth, mark sheets of all examinations, community certificate (if seeking relaxation as per Government of Tamil Nadu rules), etc.
2. The department will not provide accommodation and no TA/DA will be paid to the candidates appearing for the personal interview. The interview will be in physical mode.
3. At the time of the verification of original documents or even after selection, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to wilfully conceal, or misrepresent the facts or canvass, such application will be rejected, and due action will be taken against the candidate.
4. The date and time of the personal interview will be intimated individually by email to the shortlisted candidates.
5. The candidates who score equivalent marks, the person with desirable qualification will be given priority.
